

folded-petals flower

- Cut out the circle template. Place this on some fabric and draw around it to create your basic flower pattern. You'll need 20-30 circles to create a good flower. To make fun edges for your flowers fold a fabric circle in half.
- 2. ...then in half again
- 3. ...and again
- 4. ...and again use scissors to cut interesting shapes across the end.
- 5. Unfold it to see how it looks. You can make every fabric circle different if you want.
- 6. Find combinations of colours and shapes you like. Fold the petals up again, and glue or sew them all together to create a big bunch. You can use paperclips to secure petals while they dries. Set it on a flat surface and fluff out the petals.

You will need:

Circle template, fabric, scissors, pen or pencil, PVA Glue, a hot glue gun or needle and thread, paperclips

A YEAR OF YOUNG PEOPLE TAKEOVER...



Show us your thoughts, ideas, hopes and fears in the form of an artwork that will go inside the tennis-court-brain. Work can be in any medium but bear in mind that the exhibition will be outdoors, so think about how it might survive in different weather conditions. You could build a sculpture, paint a picture, write and record a song, make a film or anything else you can think of... there's no size restriction as long as it can fold up into a car! Just bring your submission to Mareel by September 1st. The brain will grow in the Tennis Court over the Big Takeover weekend.
