Access

Access to the building via the stage door is on Mitchell's Road, at the side of the building. The stage door has dimensions 2.9m (W) $\times 2.8m$ (H). There are treads from the loading bay to SR. The piano lift may be used for bulky items – its dimensions are of $2.3m \times 1.6m$. For productions loading in directly to the auditorium floor there is a standard 2.3m (W) $\times 1.7m$ (H) double doorway located on the SR side of the auditorium. We have our own parking in front of the building on Gutter's Gaet, as well as there being ample free parking attached to the council buildings nearby.

Auditorium

Mareel's auditorium has a retractable seating rake with a capacity of 240, plus 80 seated on the balcony. When the seating rake is fully retracted the auditorium has a standing capacity of 600 plus the balcony. The seating rake cannot be used partially deployed – it must either be fully retracted or set up normally. However, it is possible to partially retract it to make the floorspace smaller. We have 70 black armless tall-backed stage chairs, plus 200 folding chairs for use in the auditorium when the seating rake is retracted. There are 26 round tables of 1.2m diameter and 26 trestle tables of dimensions 0.69m x 1.83m.

The auditorium floor is 17.5 m x 14.2 m in size, with 8 wooden pillars spaced evenly down either side in line with the balcony face (see photos and diagram). The auditorium floor is a sprung dance floor and is load rated to 500kg/m^2 .

The stage is steel deck of dimensions 12.2m (W) x 4.7m (D) x 0.9m (H) and is load rated to 750kg/m^2 . The maximum point load is 450 kg with a minimum contact area of 0.5m^2 .

Auditorium floor to roof: 9.5m

Auditorium floor lighting bridges: 7.1m

Stage to roof: 8.6m

Stage to lighting bridges: 6.2m

Backstage Areas

There are two dressing rooms – dressing room 1 is located on the first floor next to the green room, and dressing room 2 is downstairs next to the auditorium. Both dressing rooms have toilet and shower facilities and Wi-Fi access. There is a separate laundry room containing a washing machine and dryer, plus iron and ironing board.

Lighting Grid

The lighting grid is accessible from the lighting bridges (see photos/diagrams) or by using our Genie AWP-30S man lift.

The individual lighting bars on the lighting bridges are designed to carry 50kg/m, with a restriction of 150kg/m overall along any one meter section of bridge. The maximum number of 90kg rigging personnel on any one bridge is four.

There are also two lighting bars located on either side of the balcony. The lighting bars on the balcony faces are designed to carry 50kg/m.

There are 4 motorised bars in the auditorium; 3 are flown using two Loadguard motors with winch ratings of 500kg SWL. This SWL applies to the motors, shackles and clamps only.

The fourth bar (nearest the FOH position) is rigged using one 500kg Loadguard motor with pulleys distributing the load across the truss.

The twelve-meter truss lengths rigged between two Loadguard motors have a safe working load (SWL) of 200kg unilaterally spread between the two pick up points (7.25m) and a maximum of 100kg at centre point load. No other load can be added if 100kg is present at the middle of the truss.

Additionally there is a fourth hoist bar located in the auditorium nearest the FOH position. This self-contained hoist bar has a maximum distributed load of 30kg/m.

We also have 6 tank traps with 3m poles available for floor rigging; if more are required we can hire in more locally.

DMX universe 1/1-192 and 400-450 are reserved for the auditorium dimmers and working lights. There is a DMX node on the US lighting bridge outputting universes 2 + 3 and a DMX node at the USR corner of the stage outputting universes 3 + 4. SACN patch is available from the auditorium stage and FOH control positions – our SACN network is in the 10.101.101.x range, subnet mask 255.255.0.0.
